

**Regular Meeting Minutes

The Wahoo Board of Education met in regular session on Monday evening, April 14, 2008 at 6.00 p.m. in the High School Media Center located at 2201 N. Locust, Wahoo, Nebraska. Publicized notice was given by publication in the Wahoo Newspaper on April 9, 2008.

They would like to recommend to the board to offer a full time teaching position to Darold Foster. Former coach Doug Watts and parents Jodi Gensler, John Sutton, Jay Kern and Greg Smith also spoke on behalf of Darold Foster.

A motion was made by Fauss, seconded by Grandgenett to accept the recommendation from the administration to hire Darold Foster as a combination social science and alternative school teacher. On roll call vote all members present voted yes. Motion carried.
