Course Description

By working individually and cooperatively, students in Algebra will apply basic algebraic concepts, mathematical concepts, and use technological resources to solve real-world problems and to gain a better understanding of the problem solving process.

Materials Needed

Textbook: Pre-Algebra – Glencoe Mathematics
Other Materials: 2 packets of loose leaf paper, pencil, 2 pocket folder used only for math

Academic and Behavioral Expectations

The class period is approximately 45 minutes long. There will be several guided and independent activities that will take place in that time. It is expected that the student work within Wahoo Middle School's academic and behavioral expectations. (see below) All homework assigned will be due at the beginning of class unless otherwise noted. Quizzes and tests will be announced in advance and need to be completed the day that they are assigned. Long-term projects will also be announced in advance and are to be completed by the date assigned.
