Course Description:

This class is the second of a two-year course. It is the study of the language, concepts, and techniques of Algebra designed to set the foundation for future High School Mathematics courses. This course focuses on rate of change, systems of equations and inequalities, solving quadratic equations, factoring quadratic equations, probability, and basic statistics.

Materials Needed:

Textbook: Glencoe Algebra 1

Other Materials: Notebook, pencil or pen, and folder to stay organized

Academic and Behavior expectations:

The class period is 45 minutes long. During this time students are expected to take notes during lecture and participate during any daily classroom activities. If a deadline is not given on an assignment it will be expected to be due the next class period. There will be one project per quarter to go along with any tests or quizzes.
