

JEO Scholarship

\$500 per year

Eligibility:

1. A graduating senior from Wahoo High School with application for enrollment in either a 4-year or 2-year accredited school and planning to study in one of the following areas: Civil, Sanitary or Electrical Engineering; Architecture, Surveying; Planning; or associated CAD (Computer Aided Drafting).
2. ACT scores reported to Wahoo High School.

Guidelines:

1. Complete sections 1 and 3 of the application
2. Request your counselor to complete section 2
3. Request 3 letters of recommendation. One must be from a faculty member of Wahoo High School and the other two should be either a current/former employer or a community member not related to the applicant.
4. Must be enrolled as a full time student (minimum of 12 credit hours if in college) each semester and maintain a 2.0 grade point average in the classes that relate to the major area of study.
5. Upon completion of each semester the applicant must turn his/her grades into Wahoo High School in order to receive his/her check for that semester. The applicant must continue his/her study in one of the areas listed above in order to continue to be eligible for the scholarship.
6. This scholarship is worth \$500 per year (\$250 per semester) and is renewable for up to four years as long as the student meets the requirements listed above.
7. Return the completed application with letters of recommendation to the Wahoo High School Counselor's office by **March 15th**. A resume can also be submitted in addition to but not as a replacement of this application form.
