JIM LANGEMEIER YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

Jim Langemeier Family

The Jim Langemeier Family awards the Jim Langemeier Youth Scholarship to students who are graduating from a high school in Saunders County.

To be eligible applicants must . . .

1. Reside in Saunders County and be graduating from High School this school year
2. Have a 3.0 G.P.A.
3. Have been active in 4-H activities for the past 3 years and are currently active in 4-H activities as demonstrated by showing in the Saunders County 4-H Fair; OR been active in FFA activities for the past 4 years and are currently active in FFA activities as demonstrated by their participation in the Saunders County Fair.
4. Demonstrate abilities in leadership
5. Demonstrate involvement in community activities
6. Be able to demonstrate a commitment to attending a post-secondary school of his/her choice as a full-time student for a period long enough to receive a certificate of completion. The course of study may be a one, two or four year post secondary program.

To Apply . . .

1. Applicant must complete the Jim Langemeier Youth Scholarship Application Form and submit a completed application package by the last Friday in February.
2. Application package must include:
 - a) A student typewritten essay detailing why he/she is interested in attending a post secondary institution, what program will be the focus of study, and how this will help in your pursuit of your career goals.
 - b) At least three (3) letters of recommendation from 4-H leaders, FFA leaders, community members and other school personnel that will attest to the applying student's acceptable citizenship, character and chances of success in post-secondary education efforts. Applicants must include a letter of recommendation from their 4-H or FFA leader and should use more than one source for recommendations. (i.e., Not all from teachers or not all from community.)
 - c) A copy of your high school transcript, including the first semester of the current school year.
3. Sign the application form.
4. **Completed application must be delivered to the Saunders County Extension Office before 3:30 p.m. on the last Friday of February.**

The Jim Langemeier Youth Scholarship Committee shall not in any manner base scholarship recipients upon a person's race, religion, sex or employment status.

Scholarship details . . .

The committee will name a winner.

The following shall be the manner and timing of the distribution of the scholarship funds:

- A) A \$500 scholarship shall be paid to one applicant upon the following conditions: 1) Successful completion of one term (quarter or semester) of post secondary education as supported by a copy of the term grade sheet and 2) Proof of enrollment for the next term as verified by a copy of the enrollment sheet for the next term in the program.
- B) The scholarship payment will be made to both the student and the Institution the student has enrolled.
- C) Failure to provide proof of grade sheet for the first term and a copy of the enrollment form for the next term will void the scholarship award.
- D) Scholarship funds are to be applied toward tuition, books, lab fees, board and room.
