Dear Middle School choir parents,

First of all, thank you so much for giving me the opportunity to work with your child. It is an exciting time to be part of the Wahoo music department, with the opening of our new facility soon to be upon us. I cannot tell you how excited I am to showcase your child's talent in that beautiful new theatre, and trust that they will have some wonderful experiences there that will always be remembered.

Included in this letter is some important information which will help you in preparation for future music events.

ATTIRE FOR CONCERTS: Students are required to wear the black music department t-shirts for all concerts. An order form has been sent with all of the students. T-shirts are \$7.50 and the **deadline for all order forms is SEPTEMBER 15th.** Students also need to wear plain black pants, black socks and black shoes. No other shirt should be worn underneath the t-shirt. Students need to removed jewelry and nail polish so that we will look uniform. Also, hair should be worn back and away from their face, so that facial expression can be more easily seen onstage. If a student does not have the proper attire prior to a performance, they will not be allowed to perform. I appreciate your help in making sure your child has the proper clothing for choir.

If students do not already have these items, a great way to acquire them is by going to the Senior Center thrift store. I have had great luck finding these type of items for my own children there as well, and of course, they have great deals there! ©

GRADING: Students are graded on their participation and attitude during class, and also their attendance at performances. If a student comes into class every day, does their best and attends each performance, they are going to do wonderful in my class. If a student does not sing every note right, or has pitch problems, I do not hold them against them. I do not expect them to come into class knowing how to sing everything perfectly; that is what I am here for. Each student is an individual with their own level of skill. I do my best to meet each student at the level where they are, and help them improve and meet their potential. My philosophy is that music should be fun and motivate them to want to work hard and do well. It is also my hope that they will be able to take the skills they have learned in class and apply those skills to other areas of their life as well. Learning to work as part of the "team", having a great attitude, working hard, setting goals and accomplishing those goals are just some of the important skills that I hope your child will take away from my class.

MIDDLE SCHOOL SHOW CHOIR-Show choir will begin towards the end of November. If you are not familiar with what show choir is, it is basically a group who performs music of a more popular nature with choreography. This group will compete at several competitions this year, and will also perform for a variety of community functions. Students who would like to be a part of show choir do not need to audition. As long as students are willing to come to rehearsals and work hard, they are welcome to be part of the group. While most schools hold auditions for their middle school show choir, it is my belief that every student at the middle school level should have an opportunity to explore their talents in order to discover their aptitude in a certain area.

SHOW CHOIR CLINIC-Attached is a flyer with information on a show choir clinic being held at Papillion-LaVista High School. The cost is \$35 which is a great deal considering the instruction the students will receive. This clinic is NOT required, but I wanted to at least get the information to you, hoping that your student might take advantage of this opportunity. I guarantee they will have a great time and the experience they will get from working with the clinic instructors will be very beneficial when the students begin their experience in the Wahoo show choir. It looks as if it will be a rewarding experience and a VERY FUN day!! ©
