

MUSIC BOOSTER MEETING

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 3, 2011

- **Financials**

Music Booster CD was discussed and Lori Arent explained that Music Booster CD is not in addition to the checking account balance but included in the total balance. Interest earned on the CD as of the 3rd Quarter is \$179.86 and was earning at a of 1.2% rate with a maturity date of January 28, 2012. Sara Welsh made a motion to cash the CD, Char Schubauer seconded the motion and all members were in favor.

- **Student Fund Accounts**

Student funds were discussed and the conditions for having an account were clarified that they must be in 6th grade to have an account. Fund credits were stated as students earning \$1/ credit/ hour worked at concessions and a sign-up sheet for students was given to Mr. Rischling and Mrs. Anderson.

- **Open House Grand Opening**

The Open House Grand Opening is Sunday November 6th from 1:30-4:30. Volunteers agreed to help serve, clean up and not allow food into the new area. National Honor Society and Student Council members will also be assisting.

- **Concessions**

There will be 3 or 4 families to oversee the concessions: Schubauers, Arents, Welshs, and McIlhaneys. Purchasing of a microwave and shop vac was discussed with Pat Hancock making a motion to purchase and Sara Welsh seconding the motion with all voting in favor.

- **Storage**

Brian Schubauer asked for extra storage to clear out some of the concession stand area.

- **Soup Supper**

Soup supper ticket prices were discussed. The current ticket price is \$6 with \$3 of every ticket credited to the students account. Chris Arent made a motion to raise ticket prices to \$7, Pat Hancock seconded with all in favor. Chris Arent made a motion to raise the student credit to \$3.50, Sara Welsh seconded with all in favor. It was agreed that each student would receive five tickets to sell and would require the student to either return the tickets/money or be responsible for the cost of the unsold tickets that do not get turned in. Angela Olsen suggested the student receive a free ticket upon selling five and upon turning in the packet. Mrs. Anderson suggested signing ticket packets out to students prior to Christmas break.
