Course Description

The course gives the students an opportunity to read every day. In this way they will increase their reading fluency, reading comprehension, and vocabulary.

Materials Needed

- A sturdy 3 ring binder that will hold up through the school year (this is the same binder they will use in Writing class)
- A blue or black pen
- A self-selected novel
- *Daybook*
- Class Novel

Academic and Behavioral Expectations

The class period is approximately 45 minutes long. There will be several guided and independent activities that will take place in that time. It is expected that the student work within Wahoo Middle School's academic and behavioral expectations (see below). All the homework assigned will be due at the beginning of class unless otherwise noted. Quizzes and tests will be announced in advance and need to be completed the day that they are assigned. Long-term projects will also be announced in advance and are to be completed by the date assigned.

Grading

All daily assignments will be checked into the grade book. A checkmark means the assignment met the requirements. After 3 checkmarks a grade will be entered in the grade book, based on a 10-point scale. Points will be deducted for an incomplete assignment or a late assignment. Each assignment is worth 33% of the homework grade.

Additional Information

If a student misses class, the responsibility of getting the notes, activity sheets and assignments is that of the student. Extra copies of activity sheets can be found in the Make Up basket on the table by my desk.

The student can ask questions or seek additional help outside of class in several ways. The teacher is available before school, during study hall, during 7th period and after school.
