**DESCRIPTION:** This is a web design class in which the student will gain an understanding of the elements of creating a web page using the Dreamweaver software.

**GOALS:**

1. TLW will plan and create a web site storyboard.
2. TLW explore the Dreamweaver workspace and plan and define a web site.
3. TLW create head content and set page properties.
4. TLW add internal and external links to the web page and use the history panel and edit code.
5. TLW create ordered and unordered lists, and create and apply cascading style sheets.
6. TLW insert and align graphics.
7. TLW create internal links to named anchors and create navigation bars.
8. TLW Use HTML tables to lay out a page and resize, split and merge cells.
9. TLW manage a web server and files, and check files in and out.
10. TLW maintain and update previously created web sites.
