

VADA KINMAN OLDFIELD SCHOLARSHIP
(\$2000; Non-renewable)

- Eligible: Any Nebraska high school senior who will graduate.
- Due Date: Essays will be submitted to school counselor by **September 15** of the student's senior year. A local school committee will review entries to determine the best two essays that will be submitted to the Vada Kinman Oldfield Scholarship committee. These two entries from Wahoo High School must be postmarked no later than October 1 of the student's senior year.
- Requirements: Writing an essay using NOT over 1000 words with the subject being "WHY THIS NEBRASKA VETERAN SHOULD BE RECOGNIZED AND HONORED."
- Note: There must be a title sheet submitted with the student's essay; there will be no student's name on the essay.*
- Essay Notes:
1. The veteran to be written about must have been honorably discharged.
 2. The veteran to be written about must have been born and raised in Nebraska or lived the majority of his/her life in Nebraska.
 3. The veteran to be written about does not need to be related to the writer.
 4. The veteran to be written about does not need to be living.
 5. The veteran to be written about could have served in any conflict or war.
- Award Value: Winner receives \$2000. If there are two winners, each will receive \$1000.
- Award Notes:
1. The winner/winners will be announced during the Veterans' Day Ceremony in November in their hometown.
 2. The award will be presented to the winner/winners at the school's scholarship ceremony or graduation.
 3. The prize money will be sent for tuition to the college of the student's choosing, after graduation.

- For The Committee:
1. There must be a title sheet submitted with the student's essay; there will be no student's name on the essay.
 2. Initial screening of entries to be done by teachers at the school of origin.
 3. The best two entries from each school will be sent to the North Platte Public Library; 120 West 4th Street; North Platte, NE 69101; Attn: VADA KINMAN OLDFIELD SCHOLARSHIP. Entries must be postmarked no later than October 1st in the school year in which they are to be judged.
