- Cast Party – A cast party is being planned for Sunday April 29th at the high school from 1:00 to 6:00. The boosters will help to make a meal, serve, and clean up. Char Schubauer has offered to organize the preparation of the spaghetti meal. The meal to include spaghetti, garlic bread, lettuce salad, pop and ice cream. Carrie Knowlton and Sara Welsh also offered to help. Any other booster wanting to help, are welcome. Following the meal, the movie Grease will play in the theater. Mr. Anderson expects about 60 people to attend. Cost for meal supplies is being provided by the boosters.
- Publication of what Boosters have purchased to be included in performance programs.
- Photo buttons – Everyone liked the idea and much discussion followed. We definitely want to do, but need further discussion. No specific assignments were given ore specific action items determined.
- Show Choir Camp – Camp is tentatively set for August 6, 7, and 8. With plans to be held in Wahoo again. Cost was discussed around \$25 to attend, that would include a t-shirt and meals for the students. Discussed possible food donations from boosters. Ms. Anderson to be thinking if other items for the camp that may require funds from boosters.

- Others
 - The school was looking to see if the music boosters would help split 1/3 cost of a solution one plotter/printer. Plotter could be used for high quality advertising and promotional material, as well as, for fund raising possibilities. Boosters approved paying one third of cost to lease for a three year term plus cost to operate for our use.

 - It was also discussed that while traveling the boosters will pay for one away meal for the band. This should also include for the musical groups, such as show choir.

 - Mrs. Anderson requested that we consider supporting show choir trips. The band has performance in DC in the past and she thought it would be good to start planning for an away performance for the show choir. Possible KC this summer and/or Disneyland for next summer. More discussion to follow.
