The Fremont Antique Car Club is pleased to inform you of a college scholarship that we are making available this year. This scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000, and will be available during the student's freshman year of college. This scholarship is available to 2022 graduating seniors meeting the following guidelines:

- Minimum Cumulative GPA of 2.25
- Must attend an accredited college or community college in Nebraska, Iowa, Kansas or Wyoming.
- Must enroll in a course of study directly related to the automotive industry. This can include automotive technology, body and collision repair, and classic car restoration to name a few.

The scholarship will be disbursed in two increments; \$500 at the beginning of the first & second terms. Prior to the second disbursement, the winner will be required to make a short presentation at a meeting of the Fremont Antique Car Club. The presentation is to cover the student's goals, course of study, and progress to date. (Our club meets on the first Friday of each month @ 7:00 PM.)

To apply, the student must complete the attached Scholarship Application. The completed application along with the other required documentation is to be submitted to the address shown on the form no later than April 1st. Winners will be informed prior to the end of April. The winner of the scholarship will be asked to provide proof of enrollment, and the disbursement will be made directly to the college.
