## Keith W. Texel Memorial Scholarship Fund Wahoo Public High School

This \$1,000 scholarship shall commemorate the life of Keith W. Texel, a lifelong resident of the City of Wahoo, Nebraska; an alumnus of the University of Nebraska-Lincoln (Class of 1961); and an International Harvester farm equipment dealer.

Students meeting the following criteria shall be eligible for this scholarship:

- a. Candidate is a senior for the current graduating class.
- b. Candidates shall be pursuing any major at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
- c. Candidates shall have incoming freshman class standing. Preference shall be given to candidates who attended Wahoo Public High School for four (4) consecutive years prior to graduation.
- d. Preference shall be given to students who have demonstrated academic achievement. Involvement in community and extra-curricular activities may also be considered.
- e. Recipients of these scholarships must be citizens or lawful permanent residents of the United States of America.
- f. All scholarships awarded shall be for one academic year and may be renewed for three (3) additional academic years upon continued maintenance of all criteria above and a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above by the recipient.

\*NOTE: This scholarship may have been renewed the previous year by a WHS alumnus who is currently enrolled in college full time.

Should the former recipient NOT renew this scholarship, then the WHS Scholarship Committee may provide the name of a current graduating senior who: 1) completes this scholarship application and, 2) returns it by the deadline.
