per year for up to three years**

The STEM CONNECT Scholarship program welcomes applications from students who will be first year or second year students in Spring 2022. Funded by the National Science Foundation, these scholarships seek to attract and support academically talented, low-income students with interest in careers that require strong skills in mathematics or computer science.

## Eligible Community Colleges

Students who apply to Southeast Community College or Western Nebraska Community College must:

- enroll in the Academic Transfer program
- have strong interest in careers that require strengths in mathematics or computer science
- Note: SCC students interested in Health (nursing, medicine) are not eligible.

## When to Apply

The application period begins Sept. 15. First review of applications will begin December 13 for all applications received by that date, with a final **deadline of December 10, 2021.** ←

## Need-Based

STEM CONNECT is a need-based federal scholarship program. To be considered for a STEM CONNECT scholarship, your family must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)

## How to Apply

- If not currently a student, first apply to your institution of choice (SCC or WNCC).
- Complete the Spring 2022 scholarship application in the CSMCE Application/Registration Portal at <https://go.unl.edu/scimathapply>.
- Applicants who have not submitted the FAFSA are encouraged to do so as soon as possible.

## Award

This award is up to \$8,000 per year through the Fall of 2024 at either SCC, WNCC, or at UNL, provided students demonstrate financial need and satisfy eligibility requirements. Students awarded scholarships through SCC or WNCC must attend at least one semester at the community college prior to transferring to UNL in a STEM CONNECT eligible major.
