DR. WILLIAM KARL STEFAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$200 to \$800/\$100 to \$400 each semester)

In 1991 the first award of the Dr. William Karl Stefan Memorial Scholarship was given to a graduating student at Wahoo Public High School. The school received a donation from the estate of Dr. Stefan that is to be used for scholarship purposes. Guidelines have been provided for awarding the monies and they include the following:

Guidelines & Criteria:

- 1. Scholarships are restricted to graduating seniors of Wahoo High School who are planning to attend an accredited trade school for the purpose of learning a recognized trade, or entering an accredited college or university for the purpose of preparing for a specific profession such as the following:
 - a. **Trades** carpenter, electrician, mechanic, butcher, draftsman, secretary, cook, printer, construction technologist, plumber, steam fitter, etc.
 - b. **Professions** bookkeeper, certified public accountant, nurse, paramedical career such as laboratory technician, etc.
 - c. The recipient of the scholarships specifically shall not include humanities or liberal arts subjects such as philosophy foreign languages, classics, and literature.
- 2. The selection of the eligible applicant(s) shall be made by a scholarship awards committee created by the High School Principal. If there are more applicants eligible than funds available, financial need, previous academic success, school and community service shall be considered as factors in naming recipients.
- 3. For the first seven years of the fund no one scholarship recipient shall receive an award of more than \$800 (\$400 each semester). At the discretion of the principal and committee awards smaller than the maximum amount may be awarded in order to allow larger amounts of eligible candidates to share in the scholarships.
- 4. The donor's intention is for the scholarship to be for one year only and be non-renewable, although the recipient may reapply for the award during his or her second year at the accredited institution, but such reapplication must be considered in competition with all other senior scholarship applicants from Wahoo High School.
- 5. One half of the award amount shall be paid upon registration in an approved program and one half shall be awarded at the beginning of the second semester or quarter. It is the responsibility of the recipient to provide proof of compliant to the committee or its designee.
