Scholarship In Memory of Classmate, Jane Marie Gross

The Wahoo Public Schools Foundation announced in the Fall of 2015, a new scholarship for graduating seniors intending to attend the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. This new scholarship was made possible by the generosity of Wahoo High School alum, Dr. Greg Haessler of Urbandale, IA.

Dr. Haessler, a 1968 graduate of Wahoo High School, contacted the Wahoo Public Schools Foundation to set up this scholarship in memory of Jane Marie Gross, a close friend and classmate while attending Wahoo High School. Ms. Gross passed away in her sophomore year as a result of a rare blood disease. Her untimely death, while a shock to the Wahoo community, inspired Haessler to pursue a medical degree and ultimately a career in the medical field. Dr. Haessler retired from The Principal Financial Group as Vice-President and Chief Medical Director after a 30-year career with that company. This scholarship in her honor is purposeful in that as Dr. Haessler was inspired to go into medicine, this may enable others to get a good start in their education and also achieve a meaningful career of service and help to others.

The annual \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a WHS senior who will be attending the University of Nebraska – Lincoln, with preference to those pursuing a degree in a health related field.
