STUDENTS & STAFF CLEANTHE ROADS

Wahoo Middle School students and staff recently picked up litter along Highway 77 as part of the "Adopt-A-Highway" program through the Nebraska Department of Transportation. The Middle School adopted a stretch and has proudly made their way out to that stretch two to three times a year.

The first Adopt-A-Highway program in the nation began in Texas in 1985, and is now international in scope. Nebraska's program officially began in April of 1990, through the efforts of Gretna State Senator, Emil Beyer.

In the past years, the Adopt-A-Highway program has grown to cover about one-quarter of the State's 10,000 miles of roads and currently 900 groups have adopted a section of Nebraska roadsides as their own.

IMPORTANT SCHOOL COVID-19 INFORMATION

SCHOOL DAY GUIDELINES FOR COVID-19

- I.Students are expected to wear masks when reasonable and appropriate. Students are encouraged to bring their own masks. The school will provide masks to students if needed.
- 2. Social distancing (6 feet) will be practiced consistently throughout the school day.
- 3. Commons areas in the school building will be closed. Students will need to be in their assigned areas at all times during the school day.
- 4. Hand washing and/or hand sanitizer will be highly encouraged.

PARENT PRE-SCREENING OF STUDENTS (to be done at home by parents)

- •Has the child been in close contact, without a mask, of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
- •Does the child currently have a fever of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or greater?
- •Does the child currently exhibit any of the following symptoms:

Frequent cough


Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Unusually sore throat

Unexplained sore chest

Loss of taste and/or smell

Diarrhea or nausea



**In assessing the other symptoms, these would be symptoms uncharacteristic of the student. Especially during the fall allergy season, a runny nose, sore throat, or cough may be commonplace for the student.

If any student, staff member, or visitor is displaying COVID-19 symptoms or has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days, they may be excluded. Parents/guardians will be notified, and the student will need to be picked up as soon as possible. Parents/guardians should contact their healthcare provider for further direction.

RETURN FROM EXCLUSION

If untested for COVID-19, a student may return when:

- 1. They have not had a fever for at least 72 hours, without use of medication,
- 2. Other symptoms (if present) have improved, $\ensuremath{\mathsf{OR}}$
- 3. They have written approval for returning to school by their healthcare provider.**If tested positive for COVID-19, they may return when they have written approval by a healthcare provider or the local health department.

Public Health Recommendations for Screening, Exclusion, and Re-Admittance of Ill Students and Staff for COVID-19 in Schools

The following symptom screening criteria for ill students and staff is based on the most current research. Because people with COVID-19 have reported a wide range of symptoms – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness, the following criteria have been developed to assist schools in identifying presumptive positive COVID-19 cases.

Students with two or more of the following: fever (measured or subjective), chills, rigors, myalgia, headache, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea

At least one of the following: new cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new loss of taste/smell Students and staff who screen positive should be immediately isolated in the designated area and sent home as soon as possible. Require the symptomatic person to wear a cloth or surgical mask while waiting, if tolerable.

Re-Admittance to School

Symptomatic staff/student who tests positive:



Exclude for:

- At least 10^x days have passed since symptoms first appeared AND
- At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications AND
- Symptoms have improved

Asymptomatic staff/student who tests positive:



Exclude for:

- 10 days from date of test
 AND
- only allow to return if no symptoms develop. (If symptoms develop, refer to symptomatic positive instructions.)

Symptomatic staff/student not tested:



Exclude for:

- 10* days from symptom onset AND
- At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications
 AND
- Symptoms have improved

May return to school if a doctor establishes an alternative diagnosis, presents a doctor's note to confirm the presence of an alternative diagnosis that explains the symptoms, and meets the schools requirements for readmission.

"This length of time may need to be extended for people who have severe liness or are immunocompromised. Rease consult 3RPHD or a health care provider for further guidence on those situations.

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, please call the Three Rivers Public Health Department at 402-727-5396.

Symptomatic staff/student who tests negative:



Exclude until:

 At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications (or meets the schools requirements for readmission)

AND

- Symptoms have improved AND
- Student has competed quarantine if required due to an exposure to a positive COVID-19 case

There is no reason for a student or staff member to get a "negative test" to be cleared for the return to school.

A COVID-19 positive individual does not need a repeat COVID-19 test or a doctor's note in order to return.
